- This memorial grant is dedicated to Charlene "Shorty" Harrell of the Lagro Good Ole Days Festival, who passed away on November 9, 2012 while attending the ISFA Fall Convention.
- The grant makes attendance to the Annual ISFA Fall Convention possible for ISFA members who need assistance in paying their representatives' costs.
- Any ISFA Festival member that has a budget of less than \$10,000 and has not been awarded the Charlene "Shorty" Harrell Memorial Grant for the past three (3) conventions is eligible to apply. Applications are open to any member of ISFA whose dues are current.
- The ISFA Board of Directors will award up to a maximum of \$1,000.00, usually between \$100 and \$250 per ISFA Festival member.
- The Grant winner must attend the conference, pay in full and then will be sent a check for the amount of the Charlene "Shorty" Harrell Memorial Grant on the Sunday meeting of the ISFA Board of Director Meeting during the Convention weekend.
- Preference is given to new ISFA members, ISFA members that have not had representatives at the ISFA Convention and smaller ISFA Festivals, applicant applications that are neat and complete the entire grant application.
- The ISFA Charlene "Shorty" Harrell Memorial Grant committee of Doug Weisheit of the Newport Antique Auto Hill Climb accepts the grant applications and then meets with Betty Cash of the Perry County CVB and Vanessa McClary of the Kiwanis Club of South Central Indiana Balloon Fest. They recommend the winners to the ISFA Board of Directors and the ISFA Board formally votes on what Festival(s) are selected.
- Doug Weisheit of the Newport Antique Auto Hill Climb will send out an e-mail to all the applicants as to who was awarded the Charlene "Shorty" Harrell Memorial Grant and how much was awarded by the ISFA Board of Directors.
- The Charlene "Shorty" Harrell Grant deadline is November 30 each year and the winners will be notified on or before December 10 each year by e-mail.
